AWARDS

Previous prizes annually have averaged \$10,000 in cash, materials, and purchase awards. Purchase awards will be 60% of the artist's asking price.

SIGNATURE MEMBERSHIP

Artist Signature Membership is given to a KWS member who has been accepted into three Aqueous exhibitions while maintaining continuous membership without lapse. All KWS Signature members are eligible for the KWS Signature Artist Award.

JUROR: Paul Jackson

Paul Jackson discovered his passion for watercolor while at university. He has received top honors in national and international competitions, been featured in magazines, books, and video. Paul holds Signature status in AWS and NWS. A prolific artist and ambitious world traveler, Paul Jackson is one of today's most versatile and visible contemporary watercolorists. Whether his subject is landscape, cityscape, portrait, architecture, still life or abstract, Paul captivates his audience with genuine emotion, intensity, and finesse that energize each of his creations. We are delighted to have Paul as our judge for Aqueous USA 2019 and look forward to his workshop "New Perspective on the Landscape".

Eligibility Requirements

Aqueous USA 2019 is open to KWS members and Non-members over 18 years of age residing in the USA.

Entry Requirements (please read carefully)

- Accepted paintings must be rendered in an aqueous manner on paper. Mixed media/collage must be at least 75% water-based media.
- Artwork must be original—conceived and created by you. Using prints or copied work of another artist, or copies of published pictures or photographs, is not considered original artwork.
- Work must be completed within the last four years, 2015 or later.
- Paintings must be framed under Plexiglas®, matted, and ready for hanging with a wire in place (no saw tooth hangers). Works under glass will not be accepted.
- Mats must be a white or light shade mat board and be a minimum of 2 inches on each side.
- FRAMED PAINTINGS MUST NOT BE OVER 44” ON ONE SIDE.
- Any painting previously accepted in a KWS Aqueous Exhibition is not eligible.
- Your entry will not be considered complete until the entry fee and card are received, and they must be received or postmarked by the deadline.

Paintings not in compliance with entry requirements will be returned at artist's expense.

Submission Requirements

IMAGES OF ALL ARTWORK MUST BE SUBMITTED DIGITALLY.

Either on a CD-ROM, thumb drive, or via email to KWS at kentuckywatercolor@gmail.com

Number of Paintings:

Each artist may enter one or two paintings, but only one painting per artist will be accepted.

Painting Size:

Frame Maximum: 44” x 44” Min 16” x 20”; Image Minimum: 10” x 14”

Digital images and submissions must meet the following specifications for entry:

1. Crop the image so the entire painting is visible without extraneous background or framing showing.
The saved image should represent the painting exactly and be oriented correctly.
2. File format must be JPEG, highest quality (300 dpi, minimum of 1800 pixels on longest side); no compression.
3. No digital enhancement is allowed.
4. Name each digital file as follows: “Last Name. First Initial. PaintingTitle.jpg”. For example: “Monet. C. Waterlillies.jpeg”.
5. If sending by standard mail, label the CD in permanent ink with your name, phone #, and entry # (1 or 2) and corresponding title(s) of painting(s); if sending a thumb drive, include your name and phone number.
6. If emailing, the email must include your name, phone #, entry # (1 or 2) and corresponding title(s) of painting(s).
7. Identification labels and entry card must correspond.
8. All entries must be submitted together on one CD or thumb drive, or in one email.

CD's or thumb drives may be returned to the artist if accompanied by an appropriate sized self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) with adequate postage affixed.

Entry Fees

All entry fees are non-refundable. Make check payable to Kentucky Watercolor Society or online with PayPal.

KWS Members: \$40 for 1st entry; \$10 for 2nd
(To qualify for reduced entry fee, your 2019 dues must be current)

Non-Members: \$50 for 1st entry; \$10 for 2nd

KWS can assume no responsibility for misdirected or lost mail. Please retain a copy of all images and the information you provide on the entry card.

TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR SUBMITTING TO AQUEOUS 2019 (PLEASE READ)

By submitting your work for consideration, you acknowledge and agree to the following:

Disqualification: The Aqueous committee reserves the right to disqualify any accepted work which does not meet the criteria or which arrives not suitably presented for exhibition.

Withdrawal: Once a painting is accepted, it cannot be withdrawn, or another substituted in its place, for the duration of the exhibit.

Agreement & Permission: Submission of work guarantees an agreement to all the conditions in the prospectus, including permission for reproduction in print and electronic marketing materials, such as social media, KWS website, publications and newspapers, for purposes of KWS publicity.

Catalog: A catalog of the exhibition will be mailed to each entering artist after the close of the show. Additional catalogs may be purchased.

Shipping & Handling: Instructions will be posted on the KWS website. A \$10 (hand-delivered) or \$20 handling fee (shipped) will be charged. Shipping charges are the responsibility of the artist.

Commission: A 40% commission on sales will be taken by Actors Theatre of Louisville.

Insurance: Although all possible care will be used in handling the paintings, all insurance for the paintings in transit, storage, and on exhibit is the responsibility of the artist. Actors Theatre of Louisville and KWS, and their agents or officers, are not responsible for loss or damages.
